



## **Bargello Landscape Workshop**

**with Pat Ashton-Smith**

Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> June 10am to 4pm

The aim of this workshop is to create an abstract wall hanging inspired by landscapes using a quilt as you go Bargello technique.

### **Requirements**

A Bali Pop in your chosen colours (or approx 40 strips of fabric cut to 2 ½" strips across the width of the fabric) The exact number of strips used will depend on how large you wish your finished piece to be but these will be ample for a hanging of approx 42" x 34". If you wish to make a smaller hanging then you may have some left over strips from another project. The important thing is the colours and I find the batiks in a Bali Pop blend well but have good contrast too.

A piece of wadding a little larger than your chosen finished size. I find a firm cotton wadding works best and usually use Warm and Natural 100% cotton. If you use this kind of wadding you will not need a backing fabric at this stage and will find the finished piece hangs well.

Thread to tone with your chosen colours

A small amount of contrasting fabric for borders and binding

Backing fabric to complete – probably not needed for the workshop day

Rotary cutter, ruler and cutting mat

Sewing Machine and usual sewing kit
